Dan graduated from the University of Manchester MPharm programme in 2014, registering as a pharmacist in 2015 after pre-registration training in hospital and industry settings. He then returned to the University of Manchester for doctoral study, specifically investigating clinical pharmacy practice in urgent and emergency care settings. In 2019, Dan took up post as Senior Lecturer in Clinical Pharmacy at the new Anglia Ruskin School of Medicine where he leads on therapeutics and prescribing education, is head of Year 3 of the undergraduate medical degree and leads the new 'Quality in Healthcare' research group.

To date Daniel has secured over £60,000 of research and consultancy income, including £25,000 from Pharmacy Research UK (2021) for a project to increase the identification and management of medicines related problems in the emergency department.

Daniel also continues in clinical practice one day a week, typically in community pharmacy but also general practice. He is also Honorary Clinical Pharmacist at Chelsea and Westminster Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust. He is also a member of the Joint Formulary Committee of the British National Formulary.
