

Declarations of interest, gifts and hospitality

I am required to complete and regularly update a declaration of interests form to register my financial and other interests that could potentially conflict with my GPhC role above.

I have provided an up to date list of my interests below. These include:

- financial interests – direct
- financial interests – indirect and relating closely to GPhC activity
- non-financial interests
- interests of those close to me –any financial and non-financial interests of close family members and people living with me that could be thought of as relevant to GPhC activity

I am aware that, in addition to providing this list, I am also required to declare any interests at the start of any GPhC meeting where any particular interest conflicts with some or all of the business to be discussed at that meeting.

Declarations of interest:

1. I am currently employed by NHS Improvement in 2 separate and independent roles:
 - a. Pharmacist Lead for Pharmacy and Medicines in Mental Health, Community & Ambulance services, operational productivity for 3 days a week
 - b. Executive performance and assurance advisor to Isle of Wight Trust for 1 day a week
2. Trustee and Vice Chair, Ealing Community Volunteer Service (unpaid)
3. Pfizer Ireland employ me occasionally on a fee for service basis for delivering presentations on various aspects of hospital pharmacy, predominantly related to my work with Lord Carter. Up to 3 days a year.
4. BD have paid me for 4 days in the last 2 years to be part of a multidisciplinary European patient safety advisory board. This work ceased in January 2019.

5. BD are paying me on a fee for service basis to provide support to Kings College Trust in London to help them design the implementation and evaluation of ward-based automation. August 2018 and ongoing.
6. I chair an academic pharmacy unit at Imperial College Healthcare Trust, the Centre for Medicines Safety & Service Quality (CMSSQ) for which I receive an annual honorarium.
7. I am part of a team at CMSSQ who have just received a commission to evaluate ward-based automation for Omnicell. I will be paid for my advisory input to the evaluation.
8. I am sole director employee for a company, AJ Advisory Consultants Ltd. Invoices for ad hoc services are raised through this company.
