Gemma graduated from the University of Nottingham in 2001 and did her pre-registration training year at Charing Cross Hospital in London. She worked as a pharmacist there for 7 years, specialising in acute medicine, setting up the pharmacy admissions and discharge team and becoming an independent prescriber. She moved to the University of Bradford in 2008, firstly as a lecturer-practitioner and, from 2010, as a full time academic. She studied part-time for a DPharm and graduated in 2017.

Alongside other roles Gemma was programme leader for the MS/PG Diploma Clinical Pharmacy (Secondary Care) for 10 years and now has oversight of all postgraduate taught clinical pharmacy programmes in the School. She has gained experience as an external examiner and as a partner for the Health and Care Professions Council, approving independent prescribing programmes for their registered health-care professionals.

In 2020 Gemma was appointed as the Director of Studies for the School of Pharmacy and Medical Sciences and has overall responsibility for the quality of all the taught programmes within the School, which includes regulatory approval of MPharm and Physicians Associate programmes.
