PHARMACY TECHNICIAN (INTEGRATED) APPRENTICESHIP MAPPING – OUTCOME

Following your email dated 22.10.19, and the follow up teleconference held on 25.11.19, I can confirm that the GPhC has accepted the recommendation of the accreditation Team Leader, Barbara Wensworth, to approve the Buttercups pharmacy technician (integrated) apprenticeship course.

The main pharmacy technician training course was approved by the GPhC in June 2019. It is noted that the pharmacy technician (integrated) apprenticeship pathway is identical, save from some aspects of the assessment structure which have been modified. The changes in assessment have been made in order to meet the Institute for Apprenticeships Pharmacy Technician Standard and the requirements of the End Point Assessment (EPA).

Please take this letter as formal approval that the pharmacy technician (integrated) apprenticeship course offered by Buttercups is a GPhC accredited course for the purposes of registration. The accreditation period is identical to that of the main integrated course and will therefore expire in June 2022. Please note, there is no record and report associated with this process, although this letter will be published on the GPhC website. Further, both courses will be reviewed during your next accreditation event in 2022. The standing conditions detailed in your June 2019 record and report apply to this approval.
