- Piloting with over 1300 volunteers, evaluating the pilot
- Using an advisory group of pharmacy professionals and a patient representative to guide the development
- Consulting and making changes as a result of what was heard

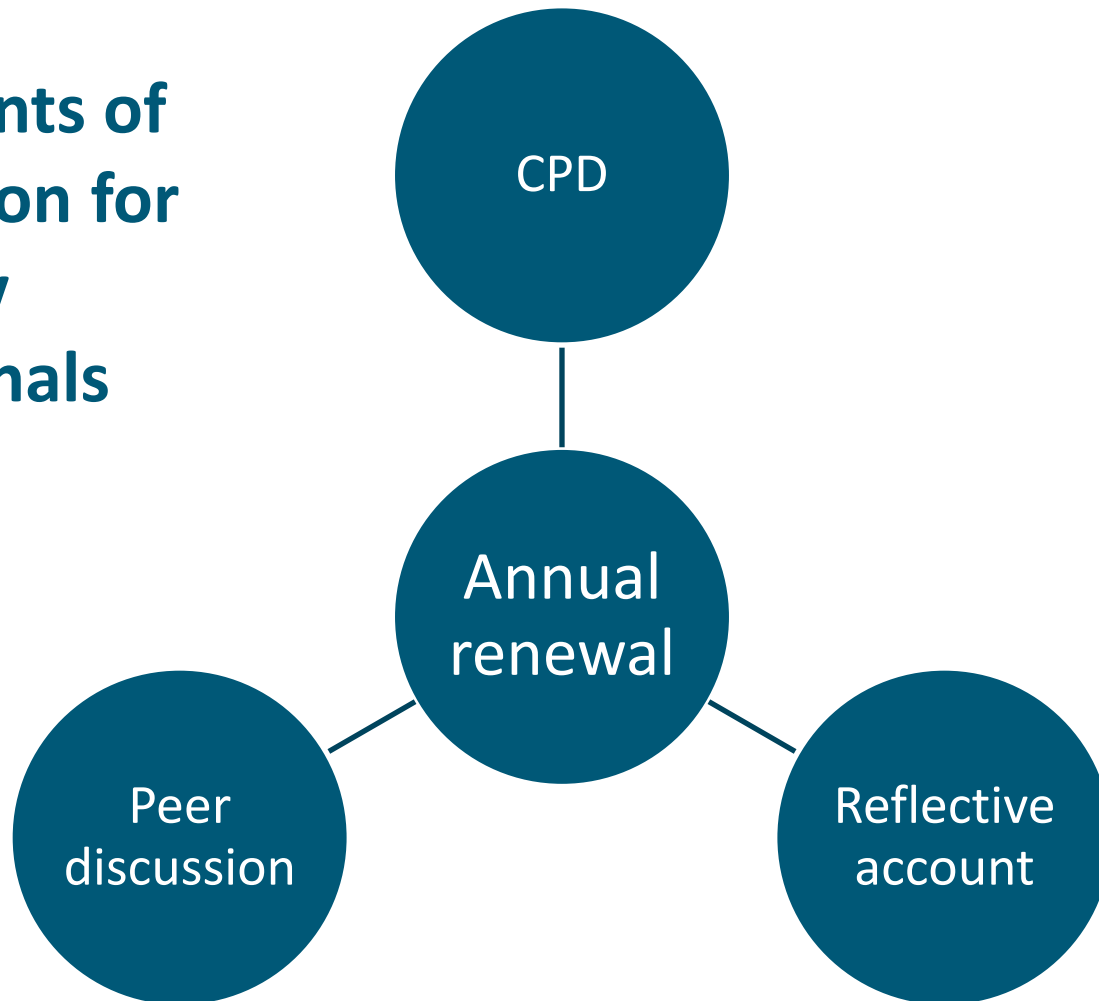


Standards For Pharmacy Professionals

What next?

- Revalidation for pharmacy professionals will be **introduced in phases** from 2018 onwards.
 - An updated version of MyGPhC in which you can record your records
 - New guidance, examples and directions on where you can get more help from other organisations
- Time to get to know the requirements and what they mean for you.

The components of revalidation for pharmacy professionals



How it works

Annual requirement

- 4 CPD records
- 1 peer discussion record
- 1 reflective account record



Review by

- A pharmacy professional and lay person
- Leading to tailored feedback and aggregate feedback for everyone

First year – submission of CPD records only

- In the first year that you submit revalidation records, you will need to submit four CPD records only.
- People with a registration renewal deadline of 31 October will be the first group to submit four CPD records when they renew their registration
- We will begin reviews of CPD records in 2019

Second year – submission of all revalidation records



- In the second year that you submit revalidation records, and in all following years, you will need to submit four CPD records, a peer discussion record and a reflective account record
- We will begin reviews of revalidation records in early 2020
