Thank you for your letter of 21st and attached outcome document following our interim accreditation visit in March. I am pleased to acknowledge receipt of the outcome and note that the accreditation team has recommended to the Registrar that the MPharm degree at RGU continues to meet the initial education and training standards for pharmacists.

I also acknowledge that the degree at RGU is approved and we can continue to offer an MPharm degree for an extended period of two years with no conditions or recommendations.
