By train and underground

The nearest main line stations are:

- London Bridge (take the Jubilee line, westbound)
- Waterloo (take the Jubilee line, westbound)
- Stratford and Stratford International (take the Jubilee line, eastbound)

From Canary Wharf underground station:

from the Jubilee Line platform, take the escalators marked 'Upper Bank Street'. At street level, turn left, and the Citi building is the first building on your left. Alternatively, follow any 'way out' signs to the street level exits marked on the map.

From Canary Wharf Docklands Light Railway station: take the exit to the South Colonnade, cross the road and turn left. The Citi building is at the corner of the crossroads on your right after around 150 metres.

By car

There are four underground car parks at Canary Wharf:


- Cabot Square car park: the entrance is on Cooks Close (enter E14 4PA if you are using a sat nav)
- Canada Square car park: the entrance on Montgomery Street (use E14 5EW for sat nav)
- Jubilee Place Car Park: Entrance on Bank Street (use E14 5NY for sat nav)
- Westferry Circus Car Park: Entrance on West India Avenue (use E14 4HD for sat nav)

There are currently 2,500 spaces available, with designated bays for disabled drivers and parents with children. You can find out more on the Canary Wharf Group website at www.canarywharf.com/getting-here/parking/

By taxi

There is a taxi drop off point in front of the building on the South Colonnade.

When you get to the Citi building



Citigroup Centre reception

Please go to the reception desk for 25 Canada Square in the ground floor lobby. You will need to tell the reception team your name, and why you are here. You may need to show your photo ID, and you will be given a visitor pass.

Once you have your pass, a Citi Visitor Relations Officer will take you to our GPhC reception on floor 25. Our offices are only accessible by lift.

Step free access

There is an accessible lift from street to reception level and a push button automatic door at the Upper Bank Street entrance to the building.

There is also step free access with a push button automatic door at South Colonnade entrance.
